
# Introduction & Ethos

# Curriculum & Applications

The sixth form will provide pupils with the opportunity to study four A level subjects. All pupils will be expected to study Maths and one Science, with the other two options coming from a selection\* of:

There will be a guaranteed teaching allocation of 5hrs per subject per week. The application process will open in January 2018 when we will publicly announce our entry requirements, details of interview process and entrance tests.
